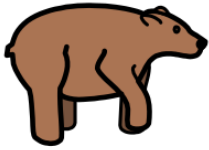

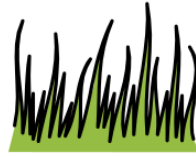

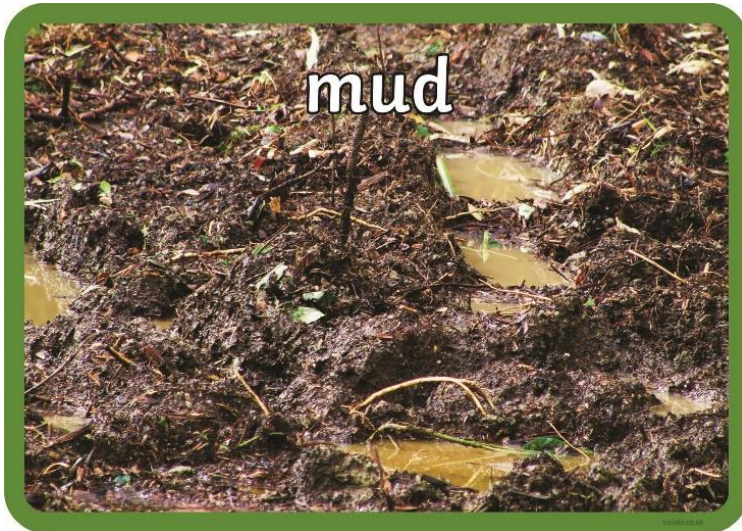

### Key facts: brown bears

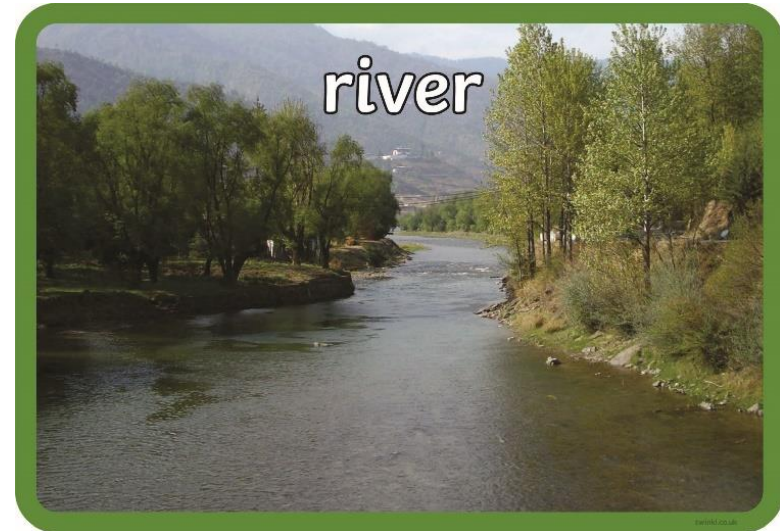
- Brown bears live in mountains, forests and meadows.

### Key facts: polar bears

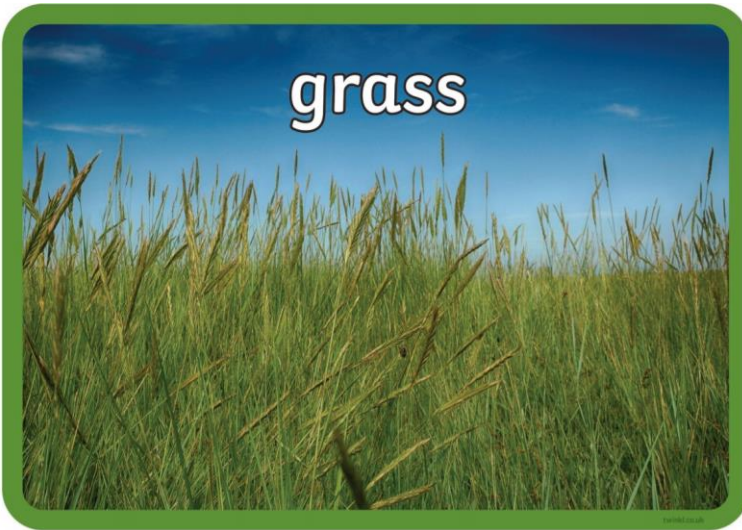
- Polar bears live in the Arctic.

- Polar bears are meat eaters.



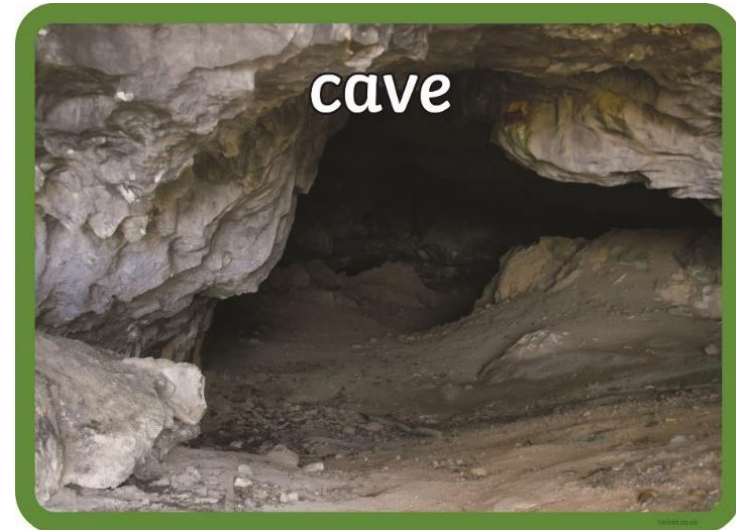
