Key facts: size

- Things are measured to find out how big they are.
- You can use a ruler, a metre stick or a tape measure to find out how long something is.
- You can describe the length of something by saying 'long' or 'short'.
- You can describe the size of something by saying 'big' or 'small'.
- There are lots of words to describe something big, including 'large', 'massive', 'huge', 'enormous' and 'gigantic'.
- There are lots of words to describe something small, including 'little', 'tiny', 'minute'
